STUDIO REOPENING PROTOCOL FOR ALL STUDENTS

Ballet Hawaii is reopening on Monday March 8, 2021 for select open classes.

There is a maximum of nine students per class allowed with one teacher.

For open classes, reservations and prepayment are required. Please email hnlattendance@ballethawaii.org to be sent the class registration link. No refunds for no-shows.

PLEASE NOTE:

Do NOT register or try to take class if you have any sick symptoms, have travelled out-of-state or have been exposed to someone who has travelled out-of-state with sick symptoms or who has had COVID-19.

A signed liability waiver will be required acknowledging that you are taking the class at your own risk and that Ballet Hawaii does not guarantee a coronavirus-free space.

A no-contact thermometer temperature check is mandatory to enter Ballet Hawaii facilities. Hands must be sanitized upon entry. If you have a fever of 100.4 or above, you will be required to leave the facility. Valid clearance from a Primary Care Physician is required prior to re-entry.

If a student or anyone in his/her household has tested positive for COVID-19, please follow the CDC's general guidelines as per below.

- 1. If you think or know you have COVID-19 and have had any symptoms, you may return to your activity after 3 days of no fever (without use of fever-reducing medications) AND after improvement of respiratory symptoms (cough, shortness of breath) AND after 10 days since symptoms' first appearance.**
- 2. People who test positive and are asymptomatic must be cleared by a PCP.**
- 3. Anyone who has been around a person tested positive for COVID-19 must stay at home for 14 days after exposure.**

Until further notice, any student who travels out-of-state will be asked to take class on Zoom for 14 days upon his/her return. If the student exhibits any sick symptoms, a doctor's note from his/her PCP will be required to return to studio classes. A student who has been in contact with/has a family member who has tested asymptomatic positive for COVID-19, he/she will not be allowed to enter the facilities.

ARRIVAL PROTOCOL FOR HONOLULU LOCATION

- 1. Arrive 10-15 minutes prior to your scheduled class. If the teacher has not arrived yet, please wait outside the front door 6 feet apart. NOTE: Teachers will be taking temperatures at the door. Once class begins, you will not be able to get in. Do not be late.**
- 2. All students, staff and faculty will wear a face mask at all times for the safety of everyone**
- 3. Maintain a six-foot social distance at all times.**
- 4. Students should arrive with hair done and class attire on. Bring dance footwear.**
- 5. Bring a clean bath-sized or beach towel to sit on for changing shoes.**
- 6. Bathroom facilities for emergency use only, so please use the bathroom prior to arrival.**

PARENTS: For the safety of all, be on time to pick up your child. Due to protocol, we cannot have a student waiting in our facility.

ALL STUDIOS

NO MASK, NO CLASS. Masks are mandatory and must be worn at all times. Please bring two.
Two students per barre allowed, on opposite ends.
Sit on your own towel to change your shoes.
10-foot distancing will be implemented during class.
NO barefoot dancing OR dance paws are permitted.
Classes will be modified to minimize exertion and limit aerosolized exhalations.

OTHER STUFF

Bring your own filled water bottle. Drink water at your barre spot only.
Drinking fountains will NOT be in use.
No Lost & Found. Any items left behind will be discarded.
The waiting area will not be utilized. Only students are allowed into the facility.

CLEANING

Ballet Hawaii disinfects its facilities daily.
Barres are sanitized after each class.
High-touch areas are cleaned frequently.

BATHROOMS

We ask that you use the bathroom (at home or wherever you are coming from) prior to entering our facilities. Use of Ballet Hawaii’s restrooms must be minimal. One person allowed at a time.

Disinfectant spray and paper towels are provided to clean toilet seats before use.
Put used paper towels in the provided trash bins (DO NOT FLUSH PAPER TOWELS. IT WILL CLOG THE TOILETS!)

Ballet Hawaii will NOT reveal the identity of any individual who exhibits symptoms of or who receives positive test results for COVID-19. Ballet Hawaii will contact the Department of Health after identifying any student or employee who has tested positive for COVID-19 and will follow DOH guidance.

All policies & procedures are subject to change based upon government and CDC guidelines.
